# Future Digital System (FDSys)

- Release 1: agency deposit + basic access tools
- July 20: beta testing
- August 3: regional focus group at Rogers State University in Claremore, Oklahoma
- December: public release
- Continued development (harvested content, digitized content, preservation, advanced access tools) requires the \$10.5 million in FY2008 budget request



# GPO's FY2008 Budget

- \$181.97 million
- \$2 million for printing and distribution of the 2006 U.S. Code
- \$8 million for GPO's ongoing digital initiatives
- \$10.5 million for the continuing development of FDSys

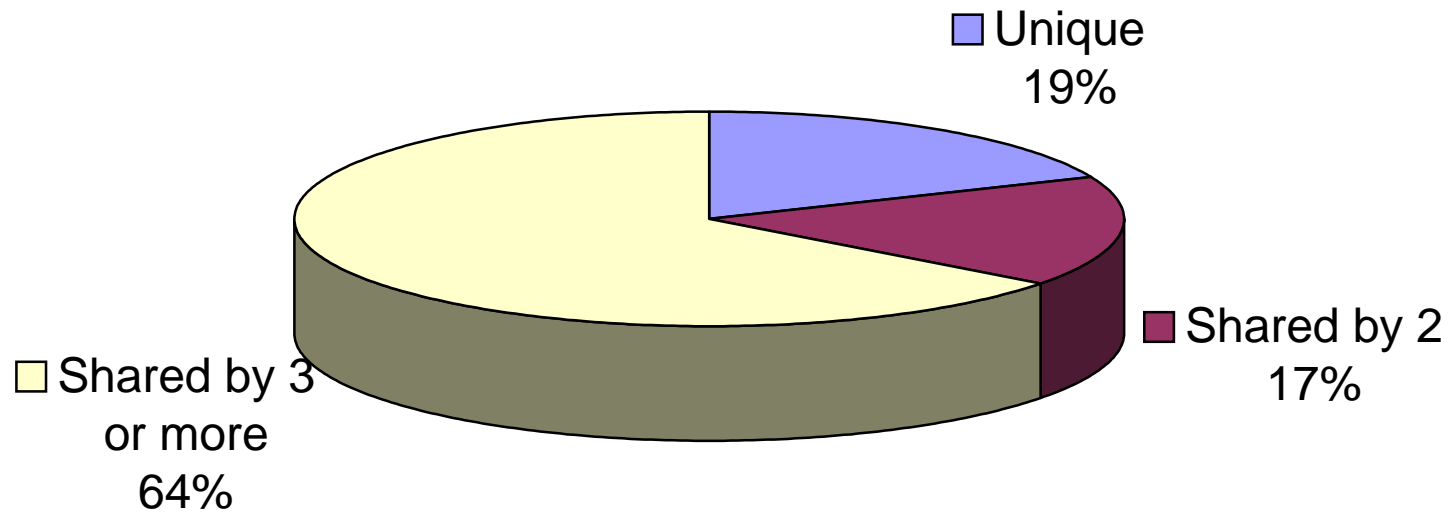
- After January 1, 1990

# Four Provocations

- There is **EXCESSIVE** duplication
- Stack space will only **DECREASE**
- Uncataloged collections are **USELESS**
- We must **SHARE** or close up shop



# A Shared regional collection

- Adopt individual titles or entire classes
- MOBIUS as delivery platform
- Cataloged and available for patron-initiated loan
- Voluntary and reversible
- No other responsibilities (really!)



# Memorandum of understanding (MOU)

- signed by representatives of the participating institutions
- reviewed by Superintendent of Documents prior to signing and implementation
- notify congressional delegations

# Government Information Online (GIO) Project

- OCLC's Question Point software
- Not limited to federal information
- Email reference and chat
- 40 institutions (from approximately 30 states) participated during the project's first three phases
- Now managed by the CIC Libraries
- 13 (+11) committed to next stage
